We are happy and proud to offer a slate of ten nominees for your approval. Candidates for the Board have submitted personal statements that are available on the [SALTLAW.org website](http://SALTLAW.org).

This is an uncontested slate. In accordance with our bylaws, the committee's slate was published and members were given a chance to make additional nominations. None were received.

There is currently a move to reform legal education. The impetus for change comes from many sources, but the instrument of change will be new accreditation standards adopted by the ABA Council on Legal Education. SALT is the voice of progressive faculty in this process. If you care who speaks for you, vote and express your support for those who want to work for you on these issues as well as keeping social justice an essential aspect of legal education and the profession.

INSTRUCTIONS FOR VOTING: Only current SALT members can vote! *It's not too late to renew your SALT membership in time to vote. Just join on-line and give the SALT office about 24 hours to confirm that your name has been added to the list of eligible voters.*

Go to <https://vod.votenet.com/SALT>. **Your last name is your user name; your first name is your password. Capitalize the first letter of each name!** Do not use middle initials or middle names. Once you have logged in, proceed through the ballot selections for the board of governors.

You have ten business days in which to exercise your right to vote. ***Voting opens on Thursday, October 15 at 12:00 am eastern time and closes on Wednesday, October 28 at 11:59 pm eastern time.***

If you can't log in, it might mean that your membership has lapsed. You can renew on line at <http://www.saltlaw.org>.

Once your name has been loaded into the Votenet system, you will be notified that you can vote.

Logging into the [new SALT website](#) to renew your membership is easy:

If you previously had registered at the old SALT website, go to "login" on the top menu, then use your **email address as your user name** and your old password. If you have forgotten your password, click to get a new one emailed to you. Then go to "membership" and renew for this year.

For those of you who never logged in previously, go to "sign up" on the top menu to register. Remember, **your email address is your username** and create at least a six character login password. You will need to fill in all of the information requested in order to complete registration. Then renew your membership for 2009-2010.
