

Professor [Anthony Niedwiecki](#), a SALT Member, was recognized recently by a national veterans group, American Veterans for Equal Rights.

Professor Niedwiecki received the Trailblazer Award for his work in trying to change the military's "Don't Ask, Don't Tell" policy. The group pointed to his efforts in drafting and passing a resolution in Oakland Park, Florida asking Pres. Obama to overturn the ban. At the time, they were only the 11th city in the country to do so.

The veterans group also highlighted Niedwiecki's efforts on the Broward County Human Rights Board, where he drafted and sponsored a resolution on "Don't Ask, Don't Tell" that was passed by the Broward County Commission, becoming the first county government in the United States to pass such a resolution.

Professor Niedwiecki is Associate Professor of Law at Nova Southeastern University and Director of the Law Center's Lawyering Skills and Values Program.
